Mr. Mendell has over 30 years experience in New York real estate, starting in the mid-70's at Citibank providing construction financing to Manhattan real estate developers. In the early 1980's, as SVP of Chase Enterprises in Hartford, CT he oversaw the development, construction and management of over 2 million square feet of office and retail properties, plus over 1000 residential units in Florida.
