Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center's extensive renovation and replacement is a significant step on a journey from institution to community. The project will move one of the nation's largest single-site skilled nursing and rehabilitation facilities toward a model of care that emphasizes community-building. Laguna Honda's new buildings are on track to be the first LEED certified hospital buildings in California, with an aim of LEED Silver.

Designed by Anshen + Allen and Arup, the building capitalizes on the local microclimate and uses efficient cooling systems for big savings in energy and water. Excellent use of daylighting, the inclusion of operable windows and careful selection of materials create a positive and healthy indoor environment for both the patients and staff. Under construction for nearly five years, this innovative project of over 500,000 sq. ft. combines the needs of a hospital and long-term care facility with superior environmental performance.

Please join Laguna Honda's project leaders for an interactive tour of the North and South Residences, the Pavilion building and a sample of the 10 therapeutic gardens that have been integrated into the site. Other on-site amenities include a petting zoo, greenhouse, basketball court and rehabilitation areas.
