Recent projects include development near Salt Lake City's transit system, redevelopment of Tysons Corner, Virginia, a toolkit on transit supportive development for Metropolitan Planning Organizations, and case studies of sustainable suburbs. Mr. Dunphy is an Emeritus fellow with the



Urban Land Institute, where he served as Senior Resident Fellow, Transportation and Infrastructure, leading high visibility projects linking innovative approaches to traffic, transit, and parking with sustainable development, and representing ULI to members, business and civic groups, transportation practitioners and researchers on transportation policy. His books and articles on transportation and real estate include Developing Around Transit: *Strategies and Solutions That Work, Share Parking, and Moving Beyond Gridlock.*

Ehren Bingaman, Executive Director of the Central Indiana Transportation Authority (CIRTA), has a diverse background in planning, economic development, policy, and communications and holds degrees in Urban Planning and Development and Political Science from Ball State University. Mr. Bingaman, a lifelong resident of Indiana, will provide insight into the current mass transit conversations locally.
