Important skills such as building construction loan and development models, using statistical skills to better understand real estate investments, developing reusable models, and auditing existing models will be addressed in detail.

Students taking this workshop are expected to have a basic knowledge of Excel and a firm grasp of basic real estate finance concepts such as time value of money, internal rate of return (IRR), and net present value (NPV).

A laptop with a CD drive and Excel 2000 or later is required.
