

Councillor Geoff Meggs, Vancouver City Council

Councillor Geoff Meggs was first elected to Vancouver City Council in 2008, and re-elected in 2011 and 2014, and is currently the Chair of the city's Standing Committee on City Finance and Services. Among his other work, Councillor Meggs is liaison to the City of Vancouver Public Housing Corporation, Vancouver Civic Development Corporation, and the Mayor's Task Force on Housing Affordability.

An award-winning journalist and author, Councillor Meggs's career has combined senior leadership positions in government and the labour movement. He served as director of communications in the Office of the Premier under Premier Glen Clark, and later served as director of communications and executive director of the BC Federation of Labour.

As executive assistant to Mayor Larry Campbell, Councillor Meggs worked on Vancouver's 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games bid; the fight to win major new investments in buses and rapid transit; the creation of Vancouver's supervised injection site; and many other community issues.

In addition to his work as the city, Councillor Meggs repsents Vancouver as a Director at Metro Vancouver, and sits on Metro Vancouver's Housing Committee.
